Travel:

By Air – Stirling is approximately a 45 minute drive from Edinburgh or Glasgow Airports.

By Road – Stirling is well served by motorway access from the North via M9, from the South via the M6/M74/M80 and from the West by M8/M80. Leaving the motorway system at the Stirling Services, the campus is reached via A9/A91/A907 within around 15 minutes driving time.

By Rail – Stirling Railway Station is some 3 miles distant from the University. Taxis and buses are available.

Festival Venue: The macrobert theatre is located centrally on the Stirling University campus. The state of the art theatre seats 468 people in the main auditorium with the building also being home to a cinema, studio theatre and licensed café/bar.
